### **Incentive for Filipino Centenarians**

The Philippine Consulate General wishes to announce the implementation of the Centenarian Act of 2016, which provides, among others, a cash incentive of PhP 100,000 to Filipino centenarians, whether they reside in the Philippines or overseas.

To assist us in gathering data on the number of Filipino centenarians in British Columbia, Yukon and Northwest Territories, we wish to invite Filipino citizens and dual Filipino-Canadian citizens who are turning 100 in 2020 and 2021 to register by emailing their full name, address, phone number, date of birth, and proof of Filipino citizenship (such as their valid Philippine passport and/or RA 9225 dual citizenship documents) to [vancouverpcg@telus.net](mailto:vancouverpcg@telus.net) with email subject: "Filipino Centenarian."

Centenarians and would-be centenarians who have lost their Philippine citizenship after naturalization as Canadian citizens are invited to apply for dual citizenship in order to avail of this incentive.
