III	a) Workers who are not registered with the POEA b) Workers who changed employers in Canada c) Workers who were hired or recruited from Third Countries like but not limited to Hongkong/ Taiwan / Dubai/ New Zealand / Greece / Kuwait / Singapore / Saudi Arabia and whose Employment Contracts were NOT verified by POLO Vancouver	1. Valid Philippine Passport 2. Valid Re-Entry VISA 3. Valid Work Permit 4. Employment Contract and <a href="#">Addendum</a> signed by the employer/s on all pages (POLO Verified) 5. Valid ID of the employer/s 6. Proof of Employment (Certificate of Employment or Pay stub for the last 3 pay period) 7. Letter of Guarantee from the employer 8. Worker's Sworn Statement on the manner by which she/he was hired by the employer (To be executed in the Philippines through the POEA) 9. Online Appointment at <a href="http://www.bmonline.ph">www.bmonline.ph</a> (choose any POEA Office to issue) 10. Prepaid return envelope.	OEC will be issued by POEA ONLY  <u>POLO Verification Fee (Bank draft or Postal Money Order)</u>  C\$11.50, payable to the Philippine Overseas Labor Office or POLO  OEC Fee = To be paid to POEA in the Philippines Notarization Fee = To be paid to the Notary Public in the Philippines
