

## **PUBLIC ADVISORY ON COVID-19**

As of 12 March 2020, the BC Ministry of Health, Office of the Provincial Health Officer and the BC Centre for Disease Control have reported 53 confirmed cases of COVID-19. There have been no reported cases of COVID-19 in Yukon and Northwest Territories as of today.

The situation regarding COVID-19 continues to evolve here in B.C., Canada and other jurisdictions in the world. A Provincial Coordination Committee is in place to respond to COVID-19 in British Columbia. This committee will co-ordinate provincial preparedness and response across sectors.

Given this emergent situation, the priority of the Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver is the health, safety and well-being of Filipinos and Filipino-Canadians in its jurisdiction of British Columbia, Yukon and Northwest Territories. As we continue to monitor and remain vigilant, we enjoin our *kababayans* to take the necessary precautions against COVID-19 by following the advice that Canadian public health officials<sup>1</sup> recommend on how to protect yourself and your family:

- The most important thing you can do to prevent coronavirus and other illnesses is to wash your hands regularly with soap and water; and avoid touching your face.
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing so you're not exposing other people.
- Avoid others who are unwell; stay away from others who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick. Contact your health-care provider ahead of time so you can be safely assessed.
- Avoid unnecessary travel. Avoid crowds and large public gatherings.
