## Availment of Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB) by Temporary Foreign Workers and International Students

To address the loss of income resulting from the economic shutdown brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Government of Canada had rolled out the Canada Emergency Response Benefit or the CERB which will provide payment of \$2,000 a month or \$500 a week, for up to 16 weeks, to individuals who have lost their employment.

Filipino temporary foreign workers and international students <u>may be</u> eligible to avail themselves of the CERB if the following requirements are met by the applicant:

- Residents of Canada who are at least 15 years old and have a valid Social Insurance Number.
- Those who lost their jobs (since 15 March 2020) because of COVID-19 and did not voluntarily quit their jobs.
- Those who sourced their income from an employer, self-employment or provincial/federal maternity or paternity benefits.
- Those who have not applied for or received CERB or Employment Insurance benefits from Service Canada for the same eligibility period.
- Those who earned at least \$5,000 in 2019 or within 12 months preceding the date of application.
- Those who expect to have no employment or self-employment income for subsequent benefit periods/months.
