The Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver invites interested service providers to submit quotations for the services of a licensed electrician who will assist provide electrical needs of vendors at the Proudly Philippines Food and Travel Fair on 11 June 2022 which is being organized by the Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver. Following are the specifications required for the services of the electrician:

1. The licensed electrician will hook up the extension wires on the camlock connector at the Robson Square ice rink.
2. The licensed electrician will be required to present his license.
3. The electrician must be at the Robson Square at 7 AM on 11 June 2022 to connect the extension wires to the camlock connector.
4. The electrician must be at the venue after the event at 5 PM to disconnect the extension wires on the camlock.
